  - iii) Contribution
- 2) Theory (approx. 3 pages)
  - i) Literature review
  - ii) Research model
  - iii) Hypotheses (if applicable)
- 3) Method (approx. 3 pages)
  - i) Design
  - ii) Methodological procedures
- 4) References (approx. 1 page)
